SALISBURY RECREATION COMMISSION Special Meeting July 23, 2024

Pope Property Update-

Approximately 40-50 people were in attendance for a site visit on June 6. People expressed concerns about the density of housing and how if may affect the view of the rail trail. Fortunately, there were not concerns raised regarding the proposed recreation plan. Danny asked about the "Save the Rail Trail" signage around town and Lisa said that there is no plan to change or pave the rail trail.

Lisa reported that the basketball courts down at Trotta are in major need of repair (very dangerous). She has spoken with Abby Conroy, director of land use office, about getting things moving by getting an updated survey of the property so that new basketball courts can be installed as well as pickleball courts.

There was no financial report available at the time of the meeting, but Lisa assured us that all was financially sound considering we were only three weeks into the fiscal year.
