Kiefer explained that the Marketplace of Salisbury is not owned by LaBonne's and there could be an EV charger there. K. Kiefer would like an inventory of how many EV chargers there are now in Salisbury/Lakeville and suggested there could be 2 next to the paddle tennis courts available without a Grove sticker; R. Schaufelberger agreed.
