Minutes:

Call to order -5:30 p.m.

1. Approval of the minutes for the meeting on February 24, 2025. Approved unanimously.

- 2. TRIP grant –progress report.
 - David Battista reported that they are working on the final design.
 - There are 2 places where storm sewer needs to be addressed through the wetlands. The team is working on that. Matt Kieffer was contacted to do an additional survey to mitigate the issue.
 - Sarum Village needs to be contacted to discuss if and how the sidewalk could cut through their property at the corner of Cobble Rd. Pat is to set up a meeting with the management.
 - Curtis will have to have a lengthy process of talking with property owners as the new design of "5ft from the road" might encroach on some properties.
- 3. DEEP grant progress report.
 - Curtis has not heard about the Road Safety Audit.
 - Pat is to get the "winning grant applications" from DOT to learn where we can improve our application.
- 4. The sidewalk along Rt. 41 from The Hotchkiss School to Lakeville–progress report.
 - We are on the agenda of P&Z tonight (March 17, 2025)
 - David will talk about design and answer questions.
 - David will show the updated plan (attached here).
 - Chris read a letter from Mr. Hochberg, the property owner along Rt. 41. who is supporting the project but notice that there are some design challenges that exist along his property. Mr. Hochberg letter is attached.
 - Mike Virzi reported that Mr. Hochberg came to talk to him last week. Mike reiterated that The Hotchkiss School would like to move this project forward while being sensitive to the neighbors and the community. To this end, Mike and David were considering hiring the landscape architect to mitigate the disturbance to the property and trees along Rt. 41.
 - Natalia reported that Kathy and Natalia started writing the Connectivity grant. The first draft was sent to the committee members. There are design and cost estimates that are needed. David will supply them based on his work with Hotchkiss.




Dear Mr. Williams:




